SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY *All humans have value simply because they are human, created by God in His own image.*

Today is "Sanctity of Human Life Sunday" and we join people of God across our nation in honoring human life and especially the unborn. Tuesday marks the somber 46th anniversary of Roe v. Wade, the Supreme Court's decision legalizing abortion for any reason. Since then, unspeakable procedures of the past - physician-assisted suicide, genetic cloning, fetal experimentation - have gained credibility. In the 46 years since Roe v. Wade, an estimated 55 million preborn babies have lost their lives in our nation. The most voiceless and vulnerable human beings are preborn babies whose existence is "inconvenient" – and embryos created merely for research purposes or "designer baby" goals. As cultures continue to disrespect life, the elderly and disabled face increasing threats just to remain alive. Human life is of inestimable worth and significance in all its dimensions. From the unborn, the aged and the widowed to the mentally disabled, the unattractive and the physically challenged, life is eternally precious. God spoke the world into existence. But He reserved his very breath for mankind!
Remember as well, God loves each one affected by the consequences of abortion. So do we!
