### SCRIPTURE:

*The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.*  
**Proverbs 14:27 KJV**

### THOUGHT:

"The remarkable thing about God is that when you fear God, you fear nothing else, whereas if you do not fear God, you fear everything else." -Oswald Chambers

Acrophobia is the fear of heights; claustrophobia is the fear of closed places; hydrophobia is the fear of water; and xenophobia is the fear of strangers. While these phobias can be detrimental, there are other fears that can have a beneficial influence on your behavior (for example, fear of getting burned, and fear of stumbling in the dark). Such fears do not terrorize or immobilize, but rather lead to constructive action (such as using a potholder or turning on a light).

The "fear of the Lord" is like that. Rather than sending you fleeing from God's presence in terror, it causes deep, abiding reverence and awe at the thought of His power and glory. It compels us to pay attention when He speaks – and obey when He commands. Look up Proverbs 2:1-5; 14:26-27; 23:17-18 to discover how and why you can live each day in the fear of the Lord.
