**MEDITATION ON PRAYER**

Through prayer you can share God's heartbeat for the world. Through prayer you have instant access to God's throne. Through prayer you can be an instrument of blessing to people you cannot reach out to in any other way. Sir Thomas Browne, an English physician of the 1600s, set an example of constant prayers of blessing. He said,

"I have resolved to pray more and pray always, to pray in all places, ... in the house, on the highway and on the street ... I purpose to take occasion of praying upon the sight of any church which I may pass, that God may be worshipped there in spirit, and that souls may be saved there; to pray daily for my sick patients and the patients of other physicians; at my entrance into any home [or business] to say 'May the peace of God abide here'; after hearing a sermon to pray for a blessing on God's truth and upon the messenger; upon the sight of a beautiful person to bless God for his creatures, to pray for the beauty of such an one's soul, that God may enrich him or her with inward grace and that the outward and inward may correspond; upon the sight of a deformed person to pray God to give them wholeness of soul, and by and by to give them the beauty of the resurrection."
