In his September 8 newsletter Fairfax County Adult Detention Center Chaplain Vic Ransom wrote, *“Recently, the jail went through a two-week lock down to quarantine all inmates as a protective action against COVID-19. My access to the blocks was curtailed and inmates were confined to their own cells. But God was at work in hearts. At the end of the quarantine, I called one man to my office. ‘How was the time of quarantine for you?’ I asked. He replied, ‘Great! I enjoyed a two-week spiritual retreat.’ He took the opportunity to read through the twelve Minor Prophets of the Old Testament. He had never read these books before. He really liked Zephaniah, discovering new truth, as in Zephaniah 3:17:*
